ON EAST ALDER SPRINGS ROAD,) 6) 7 A LOCAL ACCESS ROAD 8 WHEREAS, East Alder Springs Road is a local access road as defined in ORS 9 368.001(3), and is located off of Canal Creek Road, east of Waldport in Lincoln County; and 10 11 WHEREAS, during the calendar year 2017, during an unseasonably wet winter, a 12 washout occurred on East Alder Springs Road approximately 900 feet from its intersection with 13 Canal Creek Road; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the local residents through a contractor attempted to repair East Alder 16 Springs Road, however, during the attempted repair on or around April 19, 2017, there was 17 additional road failure, which is not uncommon in such situations; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the local residents have reportedly used up their pool of road money; and 20 21 WHEREAS, there are approximately 18 structures on East Alder Springs Road on 22 properties beyond the area of the washout; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the compromise of East Alder Springs Road has caused a significant health 25 and safety issue for a number of residents, and will make it very problematical for any 26 emergency vehicles to serve the area; and 27 28 WHEREAS, ORS 368.031(2) allows a county governing body to spend county money on 29 a local access road only if it determines that the work is an emergency or if: 30 31 (a) The County Road Official recommends the expenditure; 32 (b) The public use of the road justifies the expenditure proposed; and 33 (c) The county governing body enacts an order or resolution authorizing the work and 34 designating the work to be either a single project or a continuing program; and 35 36 WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Road Official has recommended that the County expend 37 County funds as a single project to provide access to East Alder Springs Road; and 38

WHEREAS, the unique circumstances herein and the large number of residents affected justifies the expenditure; and WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners supports the expenditures, but only as a single project, and not as a continuing project; NOW, IT IS HEREBY ORDERD THAT: 1) The Lincoln County Public Works/Road Department is hereby authorized to expend funds pursuant to ORS 368.031(2) to help provide access to the East Alder Springs Road, a local access road as defined in ORS 368.001(3), as a single project and not as a continuing program. 2) That this action of the Board is based upon the unique circumstances underlying this situation, and that it is not deemed to be precedent-setting.
