HIV Early Intervention & Outreach Services

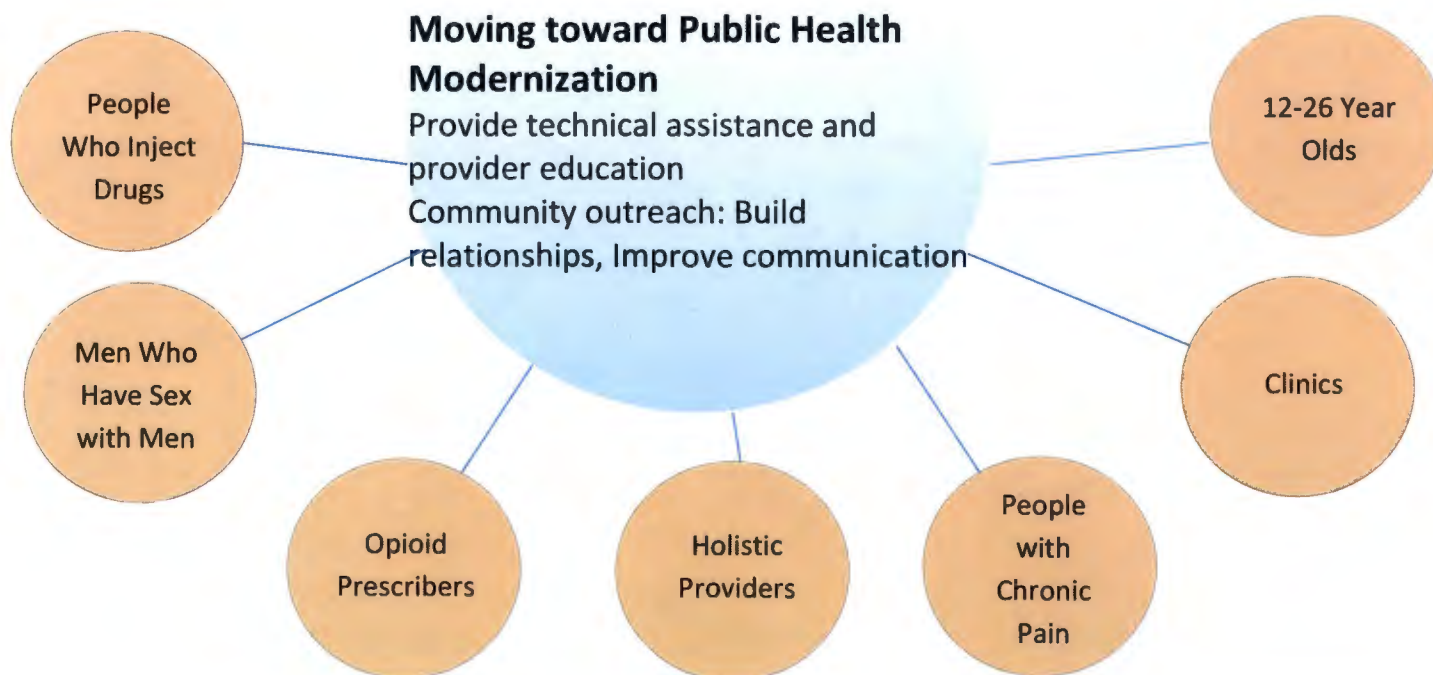
Assess community's risk factors (drug use, sexual activity)
Harm reduction in community
Educate community and providers about treatment and prevention

Prescription Drug Overdose Prevention

Increase access to Naloxone
Sign providers up for the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program
Participate in regional advisory board to implement opioid prescribing guidelines for pain management

Improving Immunization Rates

Provide technical assistance to providers to improve immunization rates (HPV)
