Lincoln County Marijuana Use

Marijuana use is a major issue among Lincoln County youth. Only 50.2% of 11th graders haven't tried marijuana, much higher than the 8th grade average of 87.9%. While tobacco use grows slightly from 8th to 11th grade, marijuana use increases dramatically.

Of 11th graders have used marijuana in the last 30 days

What could we do with additional tax funds:

- Marijuana education and prevention marketing campaign targeting specific populations
 - Youth
 - Pregnant/breastfeeding moms
 - Spanish speaking population
 - Parents
- Marijuana safety town hall meetings
- Policy change
- Student-led written, produced, and recorded prevention campaigns in multiple formats
- Prevention and education programming in all Lincoln County schools

Lower perception of harm = more likely to use a substance.
