## Voting Instructions

### Check Your Ballot!

→ To vote you must blacken the oval (●) completely with a pencil or blue ink pen.

→ To write-in a name — Blacken the oval (●) to the left of the write-in line and write-in the name on the write-in line.

→ If you vote for more candidates than allowed, or if you vote **both** Yes **and** No on a measure, it is called an over-vote.

Your vote **will not count** for that candidate or measure.

→ You do not have to vote on all contests. Those you do vote on will still be counted.

→ **Remember, if stated on your ballot, vote both sides of your ballot.**

→ **After voting—SEAL the ballot** in the ballot secrecy envelope.

→ **SEAL your BALLOT (enclosed in the secrecy envelope), inside the return envelope, SIGN THE RETURN ENVELOPE** in the space provided, and mail it in time to be received in the office of the County Clerk by May 15th, or drop it off at a designated drop site (see drop sites below).

# Measure 21-115 City of Yachats

## Ballot Title

# 21-115

Referendum Order by Petition of the People  
Ordinance 262 – Prepared Food and Beverage Tax

**Question:** Should voters adopt Ordinance 262, a Prepared Food and Beverage Tax enacted by the City Council and referred by petition?

**Summary:** The Yachats City Council enacted on December 14, 2006 Ordinance 262, entitled An Ordinance Amending the Yachats Municipal Code to Add Chapter 3.12 – Prepared Food and Beverage Tax and to Impose Said Tax. This measure results from a petition referring Ordinance 262 to the Yachats voters. If the voters approve this Ordinance, a five percent (5%) tax will be imposed on the total amount charged by a seller for all food and non-alcoholic beverages sold in restaurants as defined by the Legislation. The tax will commence on July 1, 2007 and be collected quarterly by the City. The taxes collected will be used to pay for a portion of the costs for improvements to the sanitary or storm water systems or the water system of the City. Providing a public hearing is held following required published notice, the Council may increase the rate of tax initially imposed by the Legislation. The Ordinance contains several other sections, including, but not limited to, definitions, imposition of taxes, exemptions, procedures, violations and penalties, appeals and other administrative provisions.

particular, additional tax is that restaurants use of the sewer system is one of the highest. If the Prepared Food and Beverage Tax were approved by the voters, the revenue raised could also be used. If the tax is not approved, it would be necessary to increase the user fees and property taxes.

On December 14, 2006 the Yachats City Council enacted Ordinance 262, entitled An Ordinance Amending the Yachats Municipal Code to Add Chapter 3.12—Prepared Food and Beverage Tax and to Impose Said Tax. This ballot measure results from the circulation of a petition referring Ordinance 262 to the Yachats voters. If the voters approve this Ordinance, a five percent (5%) tax would be imposed on the total amount charged by a seller for all food and non-alcoholic beverages as defined by the Legislation. The permanent tax would commence on July 1, 2007 and be collected quarterly by the City. All taxes collected by the City would be used for financing of and future improvements to the Sanitary or Storm Sewer Systems or the Water System, including a portion of the annual payments on the loans. Provided a public hearing is held following required published notice, the Council may increase the rate of tax initially imposed by the Legislation. The Ordinance contains several other sections, including, but not limited to, definitions, imposition of taxes, exemptions, procedures, violations and penalties, appeals and other administrative provisions.

## Explanatory Statement

The City of Yachats and the Department of Environmental Quality signed a Mutual Agreement and Order that establishes a timeline in which the City is required to engineer and construct a new wastewater treatment plant and make improvements to the collection system. The City's engineers have estimated that these wastewater treatment system upgrades will cost around 7.8 million dollars. The City has secured two loans and one grant to pay for the project. The annual payments to repay those loans will be approximately \$600,000 for 20 years.

City Council formed a special task force named the Green Ribbon Committee to which they appointed members from each of the various user groups in the city, including representatives from the lodging industry, restaurants, small business, non-profits, staff, Public Works and Streets Commission, City Council, Budget Committee and resident/citizens at large. The Green Ribbon Committee was charged with analyzing all possible methods of long-term debt repayment of the loans. The Committee recommended that a Prepared Food and Beverage Tax be considered as one way to raise the necessary funds. The Committee relied on data provided from various sources and individuals, thus the City can not insure the accuracy of all numbers used in their projections, but they estimated that revenues ranging from \$150,000 to \$250,000 per year could be generated from this tax.

The City will use all available existing mechanisms to raise revenue to pay the annual loan payments, including income from the Urban Renewal District, transient room taxes, System Development Charges charged developers, sewer system user fees, and property taxes. The rationale for this

# Measure 21-116 City of Lincoln City

## Ballot Title

# 21-116

Amends Charter to revise process for electing City Council members

**Question:** Should City Council election process change to one election, with candidate receiving the highest number of votes being elected?

**Summary:** Chapter 7 of the City Charter presently provides: There is a May primary election for City Council candidates. If a candidate receives a majority of the votes, then that candidate's name is the only name to appear on the November general election ballot. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes, then the names of the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes appear on the November ballot. Voters may write-in candidates on all ballots. The combination of the requirement that a candidate receive a majority vote in order to win and the right of voters to write-in candidates on all ballots means it is possible that no one will receive a majority of the votes in November, thus causing a Council position to remain vacant.

This Charter amendment will reduce the process of conducting a May primary and November general election to one election in November, with write-in votes allowed. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to the office.

is possible that no one will receive a majority of the votes cast in November, due to write-ins. This could cause a Council position to remain vacant. The Charter does not say what to do in this situation. The Charter amendment eliminates this possibility by providing candidates to be elected in one election in November, allowing write-in votes, and changing the requirement for receiving a majority of votes cast to receiving the highest number of votes cast.

3. City Council positions are volunteer, unpaid positions. The current May and November election process is spread out, time-consuming, and expensive for candidates. It can discourage candidates from running for office. A change to a more compact November election process will be less burdensome and will encourage more candidates to run for office.

## Explanatory Statement

Chapter 7 of the City Charter presently provides for a May primary election at which voters vote for City Council candidates. If a candidate receives a majority of the votes cast at the May election, then that candidate's name is the only name to appear on the November general election ballot. If no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, then the names of the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes cast appear on the November election ballot. In addition, Chapter 7 presently provides that voters may write-in candidates on all ballots.

This Charter amendment will change the process of conducting both a primary and general election for candidates for City Council positions, including the position of mayor, by removing the primary election. A candidate who receives the highest number of the votes cast in the November general election will be elected. Voters will continue to be able to write-in candidates in the November general election.

There are three main reasons for this Charter amendment.


1. Candidates often receive a majority vote in the May primary election but are required to run again in November. If a candidate receives the highest number of votes in an election, the candidate should be elected. There is no reason why the candidate's name should appear on both primary and general elections ballots.

2. The requirement that a candidate receive a majority vote in order to win, combined with the right of voters to write-in candidates on all ballots, means it
