BAYSHORE SPECIAL ROAD DISTRICT

QUESTION: Shall the Bayshore Special Road District

be dissolved?

SUMMARY: Approval of this measure would dissolve

the Bayshore Special Road District. The

Bayshore Special Road District exists for the purpose

of maintaining and improving roads in

Bayshore. The District currently has authority to

levy taxes up to 50.64 cents per \$1,000 of assessed

value on taxable property within the District.

Collected taxes are then spent by the District

on maintenance and improvement of roads

within the District.

Dissolution of the District would eliminate the District,

its taxing authority, and any and all road

maintenance or improvements conducted by the

District. If the District is dissolved, its remaining

assets would be disposed of in accordance with a

plan filed with the County Clerk. The plan generally

provides for payment of existing District obligations,

and transfer of any remaining assets to

the County.
