- FOLLOWING THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE BALLOT,** mark your choice (**USE A PENCIL ONLY**) for each office or measure.
- TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) COMPLETELY!**
- TO VOTE** for a candidate **WHOSE NAME IS NOT ON THE BALLOT**, write the full name of the candidate in the space provided and blacken the oval next to that write-in space.
- AFTER VOTING—SEAL** the ballot in the ballot secrecy envelope.
- PLACE** the sealed secrecy envelope inside blue envelope and seal the blue envelope.
- SIGN THE BLUE ENVELOPE** in the space provided, and mail it in time to be received in the office of the County Clerk by May 20, or drop it off at a designated drop site (see drop site locations below).



Why am I a candidate for the Lincoln County School Board? For all the same reasons we supported the recall of the previous school board:

- a) Poor budget decisions
- b) Not considering concerns of parents and residents
- c) Excessive administrator pay and massive pay raises

Examples:

- 1) Closing Eddyville School did not save the district any money. It actually lost the district money. They (the old school board) knew this was the case but closed the school anyway.
- 2) After they knew there were likely to be budget shortfalls from the state, they raised administrators salaries an average of over 20%. (There are 5 administrators with salaries exceeding \$100,000/year. These are not School Principals.) And, they gave the Superintendent a \$14,000 cash gift.

It should be and always should have been the Mission of the Lincoln County School Board to provide quality educational opportunities for our children. The current and previous school boards have failed to provide for our children, while they provided exorbitant wage increases and perks for administrators.

Principles I will apply:

- 1) The number one priority will be to educate our children.
- 2) Intelligent, capable, contributing school teachers are the most valuable asset this district has.
- 3) In this time of many external risks, knowledgeable and caring school bus drivers are invaluable to the lives of our children.
- 4) If we work together we can provide quality educational opportunities within the budgetary restrictions.

We should close the district office before we close a single classroom.

Unfortunately this bridge has become weakened through many years of neglect by, and decreased funding from, the Oregon legislature. This trend must not only be stopped, but turned around.

If elected to the OCCC board I will work diligently in three major areas.

- I have the higher education experience, the resources and the energy to lead an aggressive volunteer lobbying effort in Salem to make sure the funding picture for the state's community colleges, especially OCCC, will come into focus in a positive, equitable way.
- I will utilize my background in planning, marketing and fund raising in higher education to help solve the critical need for a central OCCC campus and branch campuses which will be more conducive to optimal teaching and learning.
- Calling upon my graduate degree in curriculum development, I will encourage the expansion of the OCCC curriculum to be more inclusive in order to meet the growing demands from business and industry and public education. For example, a mandate in the Bush administration's *No Child Left Behind* restructure of the nation's education programs will require that all classroom noncertified personnel hold, at a minimum, a two-year college degree.


Lincoln County Ambulance Service Review Committee



SUMMARY: Approval of this measure would allow the annexation of certain territory into the Yachats Rural Fire Protection District, provide that territory with fire protection services from the district, and subject the annexed territory to the property tax levies of the district. The district currently has a permanent tax rate limit of just under 29¢ per \$1000 assessed property value, and a five year local option tax of 61¢ per \$1000 assessed property value.

The territory proposed to be annexed generally lies to the East of the existing district territory, up the Yachats River valley, and specifically includes: The S 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec 26, T14S, R12W; the N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Sec 26, T14S, R12W; the remainder of S1/2 of S1/2 of Sec 26, T14S, R12W, not already within the district; the S 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Sec 25, T14S, R12W; the NE 1/4 of Sec 36, T14S, R12W; Sec's 26, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, the W 1/2 of Sec 25, and the W 1/2 of Sec 36, T14S, R11W; Gov't Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, of Sec 4, T15S, R11W; Gov't Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, and the N 1/2 of S 1/2, of Sec 3, T15S, R11W; Sec's 1 and 2, T15S, R11W; the N 1/2 of N 1/2 of N 1/2 of Sec 11, T15S, R11W; Gov't Lot 4 of Sec 6, T15S, R10W; and Gov't Lot 1 of Sec 7, T15S, R10W, Willamette Meridian.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Approval of this measure would annex allow the annexation of certain territory into the Yachats Rural Fire Protection District.

A rural fire protection district generally exists for the purpose of providing fire protection and emergency services to the territory within its boundaries.




