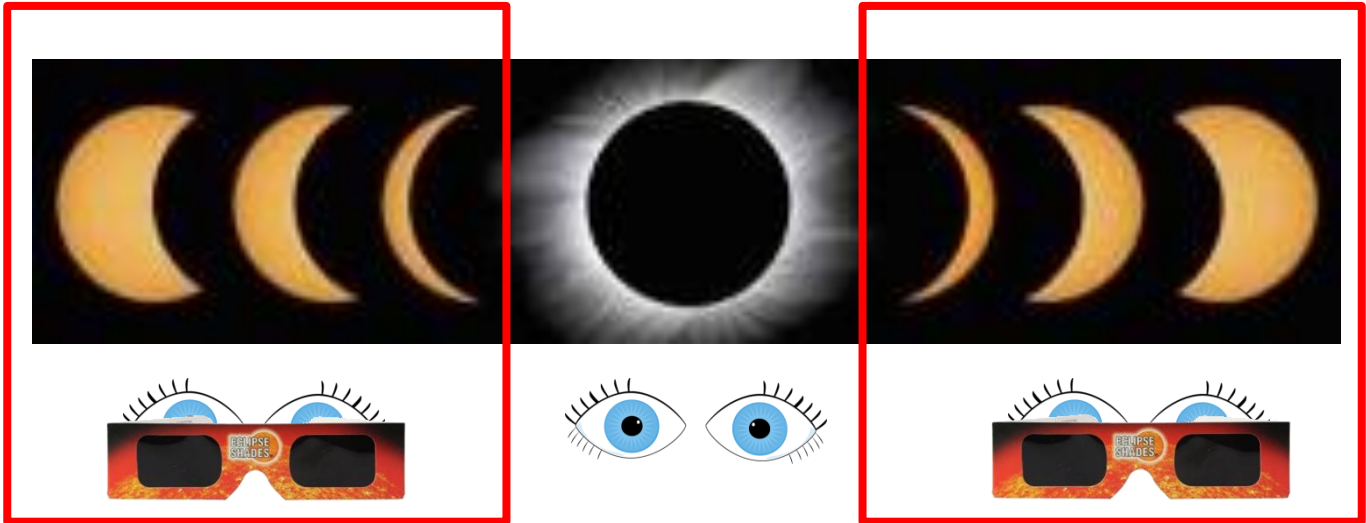


August 21, 2017 – Great American Eclipse (Total Solar Eclipse)

Important solar eclipse information for you and your family

Weather permitting, the **total solar eclipse** will be visible across the entire U.S. along a path nearly 70 miles wide on 8/21/2017. Its first arrival along the mainland U.S. is right here in Lincoln County, Oregon!



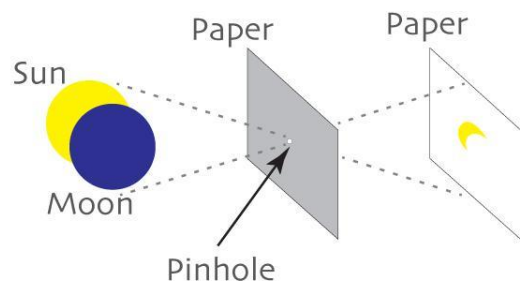
Protect Your Eyes during the partial eclipse phases! Even when only 1% of the sun is exposed your eyes can be damaged without proper protective eyewear. Blindness can even occur. Only during the few seconds of totality when the sun is **entirely** obscured is it safe to watch the eclipse without eye protection.

To watch a partial solar eclipse safely, wear special protective **eclipse glasses** or project an image of the Sun using a **pinhole projector**. Even **sunglasses cannot protect your eyes** from the Sun's damaging rays. Check online for where to get proper eclipse glasses.
