The Community Health Improvement Plan is a community-driven, five-year plan that identifies the top public health priorities in Lincoln County using information gathered from community organizations and partners. This first meeting will be aimed at re-establishing membership and community engagement in the CHIP workgroup. The objectives for this first meeting are to give a recap of what we learned from our CHIP Revival celebration held in September and to develop a mission, direction, and goals for the workgroup moving forward.
