Thank you for showing you care by licensing your pet. The license will help us return your pet to you in case they are lost. Failure to comply with licensing of your dog could result in a \$287.00 citation. Licensing cats is voluntary, but helps us reunite you in the event they are lost.

You may license your pet by bringing documentation and payment to the Animal Shelter or by mail. **You must provide a copy of your rabies certificate and proof of spaying or neutering** (if applicable) **with your payment**. You may purchase a one-year, two-year, or three-year license, up to the date of the rabies vaccination expiration. The rabies certificate must be good for at least ten months of the licensing year.
