

## ORDINANCE NO. 6

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF LINCOLN COUNTY OREGON

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRANTING OF BUILDING AND MOBILE HOME PERMITS WITHIN LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON OUTSIDE OF MUNICIPALITIES, REQUIRING APPLICATION FOR SUCH PERMITS UPON NEW CONSTRUCTION OR RELOCATION AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

THE COUNTY OF LINCOLN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Title.** This ordinance shall be known and referred to as the Building and Mobile Home Permit Ordinance.
- Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the County with information concerning any new erections, constructions or relocations within said county for taxation and any other reasonable statistical purpose.
- Section 3. Scope.** This ordinance shall be applicable to any new construction or relocation of any new building, structure or mobile home outside of the boundaries of any incorporated city in Lincoln County, Oregon, which said building, structure or mobile home shall have an actual cash value for labor and materials in excess of \$500.00.
- Section 4. Permits.** Before any person, firm or corporation shall erect construct, build, or relocate any building, structure or mobile home, the said person, firm or corporation shall submit to the Zoning Official a basic floor and plat plan, the estimated cost of such structure and its location by legal description or by deed reference. The Zoning Official shall stamp such plan "Received" and file the same in the records of the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners.
- Section 5.** Any person, firm or corporation which violates the terms of this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$500.00.

Passed by the Board of County Commissioners this 18th day of November 1969, and to become effective on the 1st day of January, 1970.
