ORDINANCE NO. 25 ✓

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR COUNTY PARK AREAS AND PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNTY PARK SUPERINTENDENT.

THE COUNTY OF LINCOLN BY IT'S BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Definitions:

- (a) "Commission" means the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners.
- (b) "Park Area" includes any county park, wayside, monument of scenic historic or recreational area under the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- (c) "Authorized person" means any law enforcement official or other person authorized by the Commission to enforce the rules and regulations herein set forth.
- (d) "County Parks Superintendent" means the County Parks Superintendent in charge of the County Parks and Recreation Section of Lincoln County, Oregon.

Section 2. The County parks maintenance Superintendent is hereby appointed "County Parks Superintendent."

Section 3. The rules and regulations for park areas shall be as follows:

- (a) Fires in park areas shall be:
 - (i) Confined to Park campstoves or fireplaces if provided.
 - (ii) Confined so as not to present a fire hazard to the surrounding area.
 - (iii) Attended at all times and every fire shall be extinguished before its user leaves the park area.
- (b) No person shall operate any motor vehicle within a park area at a speed in excess of 10 miles per hour unless posted otherwise.
- (c) No person shall operate any motor vehicle within a park area except on the roadways provided unless the area is designated as an open area.
- (d) No person shall operate or use any noise-producing machine, vehicle device, or instrument which is in any manner disturbing or threatening to the safety of the other park area visitors.
- (e) Traffic regulatory signs must be observed at all times while operating any motor vehicle.

Section 4. The following rules and regulations shall govern overnight camping in park areas.

(a) Camping on beaches, along rivers, lakes or the ocean or other areas not designated for camping is prohibited.

(b) Camping in a park area for more than five days in any successive ten-day period is prohibited.

(c) All persons are required to maintain reasonable quiet between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. and to respect the rights of others to peace and quiet during these hours.

Section 5. Swimming in park areas:

(a) Any person who swims in the park areas does so at his or her own risk and appropriate signs shall be posted to that effect.
