AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 25 ENTITLED "LINCOLN COUNTY SUBSURFACE SEWAGE DISPOSAL ORDINANCE; PROVIDING REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" ADOPTED ON THE 26TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1972, BY PROVIDING INCREASED FEES FOR SITE INSPECTIONS, SEPTIC TANK PERMITS AND PRIVATE WATER SAMPLING AND TESTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY

ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 17 of Ordinance Number 26 above described be amended to read as follows"

"Section 17. FEES. That the following fees shall be assessed, charged and paid in advance for inspections, permits and services:

- (a) Site inspection fee shall be the sum of \$15.00.
- (b) Septic tank installation permit fee shall be the sum of \$25.00.
- (c) The fee for collection of a water sample for testing shall be the sum of \$10.00."

Section 2: That except as herein amended, said Ordinance numbered 26 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist within the county for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public; therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective upon the date of its enactment.
