

LINCOLN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LINCOLN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 23 ENTITLED "COUNTY SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE - WITH NUISANCE ABATEMENT" PASSED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ON THE 16th DAY OF MARCH, 1971, AND KNOWN BY THE SHORT TITLE AS THE "SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL ORDINANCE" BY ELIMINATING AND DELETING SECTION 3.22 OF SAID ORDINANCE IN ITS ENTIRETY, SAID SECTION 3.22 BEING THE DEFINITION OF SOLID WASTES TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 3.25 OF LINCOLN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 23, BEING THE "COUNTY SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE - WITH NUISANCE ABATEMENT" KNOWN BY SHORT TITLE AS THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL ORDINANCE.

LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON, BY ITS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS

AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 3.22 of that certain Ordinance numbered 23 and entitled "County Solid Waste Ordinance - With Nuisance Abatement" passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 16th day of March, 1971, and known by the short title as the "Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Ordinance" is hereby eliminated and deleted in its entirety. Said Section 3.22 being the definition of Solid Waste for Ordinance No. 23.

Section 2: That Section 3.22 of Ordinance No. 23 is eliminated and deleted in its entirety upon the ground and for the reason that it does not permit Lincoln County to regulate and franchise sewage and sewage hauled as an incidental part of a septic tank or cesspool cleaning service.

Section 3: Lincoln County Ordinance No. 23 entitled "County Solid Waste Ordinance - With Nuisance Abatement" passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 16th day of March, 1971 and known by the short title as the "Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Ordinance" is hereby amended to include a Section 3.25 defining solid wastes for the above described Ordinance No. 23. Said Section 3.25 is to read as follows:

"Section 3.25: SOLID WASTE. All putrescible and non-putrescible wastes, whether in solid or liquid form, including but not limited to liquid-carried industrial wastes, sewage, sewage hauled as an incidental part of a septic tank or cesspool cleaning service, garbage, rubbish, ashes, paper, cardboard, street refuse, industrial wastes, swill, demolition and construction wastes, abandoned vehicles or parts thereof, discarded home and industrial appliances, manure, vegetable or animal solid and semi-solid wastes, dead animals and other solid materials."

Regularly passed and adopted this 30th day of October, 1973.
