AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LINCOLN COUNTY MAJOR PARTITION AND STREET DEDICATION ORDINANCE, #36-A, MARCH 1975, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Board of County Commissioners for Lincoln County, Oregon does ordain as follows:

That Major Partition and Street Dedication Ordinance #36-A, 1975, Lincoln County, Oregon be amended to include the following:

SECTION XIV. FEES

SECTION XIV: FEES. The following fee shall be paid by the person requesting a major partition or street dedication at the time the request is submitted for consideration.

- (1) Major partition \$ 25.00
- (2) Street dedication 25.00

That this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and that this Ordinance takes effect on its adoption.
