Ordinance No. 66

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LINCOLN COUNTY ORDINANCE #64, 1977, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Lincoln County
adopted Ordinance #64 on October 5, 1977, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance contained a technical error;

The Board of County Commissioners for Lincoln County,
Oregon, ordains as follows:

(1) That the description of the area referred in
Section (1) of Ordinance #64 be amended from "Division 5, Block 4,
lots 43 - 46" to "Division 6, Block 4, lots 43 - 66".

(2) That the zoning maps of Lincoln County Zoning
Ordinance #34, 1974, be amended in accordance with Section (1)
above.

(3) That this Ordinance being necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety,
an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes
effect on it's adoption.
