ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AND RENAMING PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE LINCOLN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON, BY ITS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Those public thoroughfares located within the corporate boundaries of the Depoe Bay Rural Fire Protection District are hereby named, or renamed, and shall be known as set forth in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, said Exhibit setting forth the present name, the proposed name under which such thoroughfare shall be known upon the effective date of the ordinance, and the number of the Lincoln County Assessor's map on which such thoroughfare appears, with respect to streets which are being renamed, and setting forth a description of the street, its proposed name and the assessor's map and location thereof, with respect to unnamed public thoroughfares.

2. As provided in ORS 215.130, this ordinance shall not apply to the area inside any incorporated city, except as provided in ORS 227.310 and except as to cities not regularly operating as such through elected governmental officials.

3. This ordinance shall take effect on the 90th day after the date of its adoption.

Gentlemen:

Enclosed herewith please find a proposed ordinance for adoption by the Board of County Commissioners renaming the streets in the Depoe Bay Fire Protection District, and a copy of my letter to the newspaper and to Mr. Jay Williams.

I am not aware of any legal requirement for publication of notice, so I assume that the publication requested was simply for general informational purposes for the public. As I understand it, you can go ahead and have your first reading of the ordinance on January 27, 1976 as you had originally planned, and at that time the public can speak on the matter. Then, since this is not an emergency ordinance, there should be another reading of the ordinance scheduled for another day at least 13 days after the January 27th date. February 10 would appear to work for this purpose.

At each hearing, if there are no members of the public interested in discussing the ordinance, and if no member of the Board of Commissioners requests that the ordinance be read in full, the ordinance can be read by title only.

I did not include an emergency clause since none was requested, and this ordinance would therefore be effective 90 days after passage.

Also, I don't know any of the streets listed fall within the City of Depoe Bay, but by statute the ordinance cannot effect the streets within an incorporated city.
