AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF PARKING, OVERNIGHT
CAMPING AND STORAGE OF PROPERTY AT THE DEPOE BAY COUNTY PARK.

The Board of County Commissioners for Lincoln County,
Oregon, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish procedures governing the parking of motor vehicles and boat trailers, overnight camping and the storage of property at the Depoe Bay County Park, to ensure the efficient and orderly use of said park by the Public, and to ensure that said park will be accessible for maintenance work by the Lincoln County Public Works Department.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS. As used in the provisions of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) **Area Described:** The area known as "Depoe Bay County Park."
- (2) **Board:** Means the Lincoln County Board of County Commissioners.
- (3) **Motor Vehicle:** Means every self-propelled vehicle and vehicle designed for self-propulsion, except police and other emergency vehicles.
- (4) **Parking Area:** Means any space, marked or unmarked, in the area described which may be or is used for the parking of motor vehicles, boat trailers or the storage of property.
- (5) **Roads:** Means all areas used for the travel or moving of vehicles within the area described.
- (6) **Storage:** Means the leaving of personal property unattended in the area described.

(7) Camping: Means the placing or pitching of tents or other equipment for the purpose of staying overnight or for a limited period during proscribed hours at the area described.

(8) Boat Trailers: Means any device designed for transportation of boats.

SECTION 3: GENERAL INFORMATION. The parking area, and boat launching area of the Depoe Bay County Park, due to the use thereof by the public, has become inadequate to meet the needs of the greatest number of people. The Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that people park campers, automobiles, boat trailers, other motor vehicles and store personal property at the Depoe Bay County Park to the detriment of the public generally. The intent of the Board is to restrict the use of Depoe Bay County Park during peak times of use to better serve the people making valid use of this facility.

SECTION 4: PROHIBITED PARKING. No motor vehicle shall be parked at the area described for a period of time longer than forty-eight (48) hours.

SECTION 5: PROHIBITED CAMPING. Camping in the area described is prohibited.

SECTION 6: BOAT TRAILER PARKING. Boat trailers may be parked at the area described for a period no longer than forty-eight (48) hours.

SECTION 7: PROHIBITED STORAGE. No storage shall be allowed between the first day of April and the first day of November in the area described.

SECTION 8: TEMPORARY STORAGE. Between the second day of November and the last day of March, temporary storage and parking shall be allowed, provided:

- (a) That the person desiring storage space or parking space receive permission from the Board; and
- (b) That the person desiring storage space or parking space pay a fee for the privilege of using the area described for such purposes at a monthly rental of: \$ N/A.

SECTION 9: PENALTIES. Violation of this Ordinance is a misdemeanor as provided in ORS 275.990. Each day of a continuous violation of these regulations shall be deemed a new, separate and distinct violation of such regulation.

SECTION 10: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Whereas, it is deemed by this Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oregon, that it is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the County of Lincoln, State of Oregon, that this ordinance be effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective immediately.

IT IS SO ORDERED by this Board of County Commissioners on this 29th day of June, 1977.
