AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF PARKING AND OVERNIGHT CAMPING ON SOUTH BEACH WAYSIDE.

The Board of County Commissioners for Lincoln County, Oregon, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish regulations governing the parking of motor vehicles and overnight camping on an area more particularly described as:

Center line description of County Road #568 being in Section 17 and Tide lands adjacent, T 11 SR 11 W of the Willamette Meridian, Lincoln County, Oregon.

Beginning at center line Station 0+00 that is 20 feet north of the north west corner of Block 7, Plat of South Beach, said Station also being south 91.10 feet and west 288.40 feet from brass cap monument S.B.P. 10 of the Lambert Projection; thence S 89° 42' W 64.65 feet; thence S 64° 48' 30" W 840.73 feet to Station 9+05.38; thence S 64° 13' W 1686.34 feet to Station P.C. 25+91.72; thence along the arc of a 16° curve left (the long chord of which bears S 50° 23' W 171.24 feet) a distance of 172.92 feet to Station P.T. 27+64.64; thence S 36° 33' W 112.68 feet to Station P.C. 28+77.32; thence along the arc of a 16° curve right (the long chord of which bears S 50° 43' 15" W 175.34 feet) a distance of 177.14 feet to Station 30+54.46; thence S 64° 53' 30" W 585.46 feet to Station 36+39.92; thence S 71° 48' 30" W 382.40 feet to Station 40+22.32; thence along the arc of a 16° curve right (the long chord of which bears S 79° 44' W 98.75 feet) a distance of 99.06 feet to Station P.T. 41+21.38; thence S 87° 39' 30" W 65.10 feet to Station P.C. 41+86.48; thence along the arc of a 16° curve left (the long chord of which bears S 75° 52' 30" W 146.26 feet) a distance of 146.26 feet to Station P.T. 43+33.77 the terminus point of this road.

Said road to be 60 feet in width 30 feet on either side of the above described line from Station 0+00 to Station 30+54.46 from Station 30+54.46 to Station 41+21.38 width will be 180 feet 30 feet on the northerly side and 150 feet on the southerly side from Station 41+21.38 to Station 43+33.77 width will be 60 feet 30 feet on either side of said center line, a County Road also known as SOUTH BEACH WAYSIDE.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS. As used in the provisions of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) **Area Described:** Means the South Beach Wayside [see legal description above].
- (2) **Board:** Means the Lincoln County Board of County Commissioners.
- (3) **Motor Vehicle:** Means every self-propelled vehicle and vehicle designed for self-propulsion, except police and other emergency motor vehicles, and does not include camping or sleeping facility vehicles.
- (4) **Camping and Sleeping Facility Vehicles:** Means any motor vehicle or device designed for overnight camping, including but not limited to campers, motor homes, travel trailers and tent trailers.
- (5) **Camping:** Means the placing or pitching of tents, the placing of camping or sleeping facility vehicles, or other equipment for the purpose of staying overnight or for a limited period during proscribed hours at the area described.

SECTION 3: GENERAL INFORMATION. The South Beach Wayside is currently being used by the public for overnight camping. The Board is of the opinion that this is an improper use for a public road.

SECTION 4: PROHIBITED PARKING. Parking a motor vehicle in the area described between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. is prohibited.

SECTION 5: PROHIBITED CAMPING. Camping in the area described is prohibited between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

SECTION 6: PENALTIES. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$250.00.

SECTION 7: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Whereas, it is deemed by this Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oregon, that it is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the County of Lincoln, State of Oregon, that this ordinance be effective immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective immediately.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted the Board of County Commissioners under ORS 203.035.

IT IS SO ORDERED by this Board of County Commissioners on this 29th day of June, 1977.
