AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR VACATION PROCEEDINGS AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, ORS 271.010 requires petitions to vacate a  
road, highway, street, alley or common other than a county road  
or state highway, to be accompanied by a filing fee in an amount  
set by the county governing body adequate for the covering the  
costs of investigating and acting on such petitions,

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as  
follows:

(1) A petition for vacation as provided in  
ORS 271.010 shall be accompanied by a filing fee in the sum  
of \$100.00; or \$50.00 (each Dept. used) Surveying/Engineering.

(2) This Ordinance being necessary for the im-  
mediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an  
emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect  
on adoption.
