Ordinance No. 71

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LINCOLN COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE #34, 1974, AS AMENDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has conducted a Public Hearing on August 31, 1977, and has issued Findings and Conclusions.

The Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oregon, ordains as follows:

(1) That the zoning maps of Lincoln County zoning Ordinance #34, 1974, be amended to change the zoning of tax lot 100, Section 10C, T13S, R11W, W.M., from A-1, Natural Resources, to A-2, Rural Residential.

(2) That this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect on its adoption.
