Ordinance No. 72

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ALSEA BAY REGIONAL LAND AND WATER USE PLAN, 1975, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners conducted a Public Hearing on August 31, 1977, and issued findings and conclusions dated November 16, 1977.

The Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County, Oregon ordains as follows:

(1) That the Alsea Bay Regional Land and Water Use Plan, 1975, be amended to change the designation of tax lots 100 and 101 of Section 100, 900 of Section 9 and 100 and 801 of Section 16, all in T13S, R11W, W.M., from "Farm-Forest Recreation" to "Rural-Residential".

(2) That this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance takes effect upon it's adoption.
