AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 1972 SILETZ BAY REGIONAL LAND AND WATER
USE PLAN MAPS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Don Morris and Weathershed Inc. applied to the
Lincoln County Planning Commission for a Land Use Plan Change
from Farm/Forest to General Industrial on property located east
of U.S. Highway 101, in the Lincoln City area, at the end of
County Road 107, and identified on Assessor's map 7-11-23, tax
lots 1000, 1001, 1002, 1200, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission voted to recommend
approval of the above request, and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been filed with the Board re-
garding the Planning Commission decision, and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners affirms

THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS:

1. That the Land Use Plan designation on property
located east of U.S. Highway 101, in the Lincoln City area, at
the end of County Road 107, and identified on Assessor's
map 7-11-23, tax lots 1000, 1001, 1002, 1200 be changed from
"Farm/Forest" to "General Industrial".
