zone change from A-1 (Natural Resource) to I-1 (General Indus-

on Assessor's map 7-11-23, tax lots 1000, 1001, 1002, 1200, and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Planning Commission voted
to recommend approval of the request, and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been filed with the Board re-
garding the Planning Commission decision, and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners

THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS:

1. That the zoning of property located east of U.S.
Highway 101, in the Lincoln City area, at the end of County
Road 107, and identified on Assessor's map 7-11-23, tax lots
1000, 1001, 1002, 1200 be changed from A-1 (natural resources
to I-1 (general industrial).

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2. That this ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared, and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
