Ordinance # 126

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR VACATION PROCEEDINGS AND REPEALING LINCOLN COUNTY ORDINANCE #69

WHEREAS, ORS 271.010 requires petitions to vacate a road, highway, street, alley, other than a county road or state highway, to be accompanied by a filing fee in an amount set by the county governing body adequate for covering the cost of investigation and acting on such petitions, and

WHEREAS, ORS 368.565 provides that a petition for the vacation of a county road or a petition to decrease the width of a county road shall be accompanied by a filing fee in an amount fixed by the governing body, and

WHEREAS, ORS 203.035 authorizes Lincoln County to exercise authority within the county over matters of county concern to the fullest extent allowed by constitutions and laws of the United States and of this state as if each particular power comprised in that general authority were specifically listed in ORS 203.030 to 203.065,

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

SECTION I. VACATION OF PUBLIC ROADS A petition for vacation as provided in ORS chapter 271 shall be accompanied by a filing fee in the sum of \$150.
