Ordinance # 127

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FEES FOR ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, ORS 471.210 authorizes Lincoln County to set fees for recommendations on the issuance of liquor licenses by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission,

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS "Liquor License" means a license issued by the Oregon State Liquor Control Commission for the manufacture, distribution, sale, fermentation, distillation, or rectifying of alcoholic liquor.

SECTION II. FEES Every applicant for a liquor license whose license is referred to Lincoln County for recommendation by the Oregon State Liquor Control Commission shall pay the following fees to the county clerk:

- 1. Package Store License, \$12.50
- 2. All other licenses, \$25.
