Ordinance # 133

AN ORDINANCE REMOVING JURISDICTION OVER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WAYS OF NECESSITY FROM LINCOLN COUNTY TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF LINCOLN COUNTY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

Section I JURISDICTION Jurisdiction to establish a way of necessity as defined in ^{OR's ch 376} ~~Section 1~~, chapter 876, Oregon Laws, ~~1979~~ shall be in the Lincoln County Circuit Court.

Section 2 EXISTING PETITIONS Nothing in this ordinance shall affect a proceeding to establish a way of necessity if the proceeding is initiated before the effective date of this ordinance except where a petition is dismissed for cause by the Board.
