AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #34 SECTION 12.080, ORDINANCE #36 SECTION X, AND ORDINANCE #120 SECTION X, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

Section I: Ordinance #34, Zoning, Section 12.080, hereby is amended to read:

"Section 12.080. Violation and Penalties. Any violation of any provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced pursuant to chapter ten Lincoln County Code."

Section II: Ordinance #36, Subdivision Regulations, Section X, hereby is amended to read:

"SECTION X. PENALTY AND ENFORCEMENT

"Violation of any provision of this ordinance is punishable upon conviction under the provisions of ORS chapter 92 and ORS chapter 215, and chapter ten Lincoln County Code."

Section III: Ordinance #120, Major Land Partition and Street Dedication, Section X, hereby is amended to read:

"SECTION X. PENALTY AND ENFORCEMENT


"Violation of any provision of this ordinance is punishable upon conviction under the provisions of ORS chapter 92 and ORS chapter 215, and chapter ten Lincoln County Code."


