Ordinance # 173
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 155, CHAPTER TWO, ENVIRONMENT
AND HEALTH, SECTION 2.240, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

Section 2.240 of chapter two of the Lincoln County Code shall be amended to read:

"2.240 Unauthorized Dumping Prohibited

"Except as provided in section 2.155 and in the definition of 'disposal site' in section 2.110:

"(1) no person shall dispose of solid waste on any land not a disposal site authorized by the Board; however, a disposal site for land clearing waste, which shall include stumps and other vegetative matter, may be authorized as provided by Lincoln County Zoning Standards for filling.

"(2) no person shall use or permit to be used any land within the county as a public or private disposal site without approval of the Board; except as provided in (1) above;

"(3) nothing in this section shall prohibit the accumulation or temporary storage of solid waste in receptacles provided for that purpose in compliance
