AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN
THE JURISDICTION OF LINCOLN COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION I: Opening a Public Road

Any person desiring to open a public road not presently used for vehicular traffic shall file an application with the engineer on a form or forms provided by the engineer.

SECTION II: Conditions of Road Opening

The engineer may condition the opening of a public to ensure protection of adjacent property owners and to ensure the installation of improvements sufficient to handle the potential traffic volume of the opened road.

SECTION III: Emergency Clause

This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect on its adoption.
