12 ject to the applicable provisions of Articles IV, V, VII, and XIII
13 of this ordinance:

14 "Y. Theatre/Performing Arts Center."

15 2. That the resolution of the planning commission are
16 adopted as findings of this Board.

17 3. That this ordinance, being necessary for the imme-
18 diate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an
19 emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon
20 its adoption.
