AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #155, THE LINCOLN COUNTY CODE,
CHAPTER SEVEN, SECTION 7.210(7), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

1. That to chapter 7, section 7.210(7), the following be added at the end of the sentence: ". . . in a full calendar month of employment.", so that chapter 7, section 7.210(7) reads:

"(7) 'Continuous Service' or 'Continuous Month(s)' means service in the employ of the county for not less than 16 working days in a full calendar month of employment."


2. That the memorandum of the personnel officer be adopted as findings of this Board.


