Lincoln County Legal Counsel

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LINCOLN COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 9, SECTIONS 9.005, DEFINITIONS, and 9.015, OVERNIGHT CAMPING, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION I: AMENDMENTS

That chapter 9, section 9.005 be amended to read as follows:

"9.005 Definitions

"As used in sections 9.005 to 9.015, unless the context requires otherwise:

"(1) 'Park Area' means any lands accepted as a county park pursuant to ORS chapter 275.

"(2) 'Motor Vehicle' means every self-propelled vehicle and vehicle designed for self-propulsion, except police and other emergency motor vehicles, and does not include camping or sleeping facility vehicles.

"(3) 'Sleeping Facility Vehicle' means any motor vehicle or device designed for overnight camping, including but not limited to campers, motor homes, travel trailers, and tent trailers.

"(4) 'Camping' means the placing or pitching of tents, the placing of camping or sleeping facility vehicles, or other equipment for the purpose of staying overnight or for a limited period during proscribed hours at the park or designated county road."

That chapter 9, section 9.015 be amended to read as follows:

1 "9.015 Overnight Camping

2 "(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to camp
3 in a county park or on a designated county road
4 either in a tent, trailer, mounted camper,
5 motor vehicle, or sleeping facility vehicle,
6 except in areas specifically designated as
7 public camp grounds.

8 "(2) Camping in the areas described is prohibited
9 between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

10 "(3) In designated camping areas, residence shall
11 be limited to 10 consecutive days in any park.


12 "(4) Violation of this regulation shall be pun-
13 ishable, upon conviction, by a fine of not more
14 than \$250."

15 SECTION II. EMERGENCY CLAUSE


16 That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency
18 is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its
19 adoption.
