AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #155 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER SIX FOR REMOVING JURISDICTION OVER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WAYS OF NECESSITY FROM LINCOLN COUNTY TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF LINCOLN COUNTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS

as follows:

Section 6.605

Jurisdiction to establish a way of necessity, as defined in the Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 376, shall be in the Lincoln County Circuit Court.

Section 6.610

Nothing in this subtitle shall affect a proceeding to establish a way of necessity if the proceeding is initiated before the effective date of this subtitle, except where a petition is dismissed for cause by the Board.

That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
