13 Section 3.010 is hereby amended to read:





22 designated as the Lincoln County Building Code."


23 That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate

Lincoln County Legal Counsel

Since the 1982 Oregon Revised Editions of the Uniform Building Code and Uniform Mechanical Code have been adopted by the State and went into effect August 1, 1983; and since state law requires adoption by local jurisdictions of all changes in reference adopted state laws; would you please recommend to the Board, adoption of both the Oregon Revised Editions of the 1981 Uniform Building Code and the 1982 Uniform Mechanical Code.

Section 3.010 of the County Code should be changed to read:

Adoption

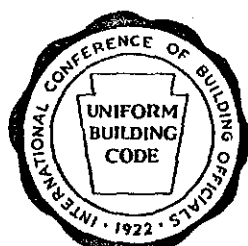
