AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #155, CHAPTER FOUR, BUSINESS REGULATIONS, SECTION 4.130, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS as follows:

Section 4.130 of chapter four of the Lincoln County Code shall be amended to read:

"4.130 Permit Issuance

"The Board shall include in the permit terms and conditions it finds necessary in order to preserve the public health and safety and comply with §§4.105 through 4.160. Upon an applicant's satisfactory compliance with the requirements of this ordinance and reasonable conditions and terms imposed pursuant thereto, the Board, with the advice and assistance of the sheriff, health department, and fire officials, shall issue an entertainment assembly permit. The Board shall provide an applicant whose application is rejected or who contests the terms and conditions of a permit an opportunity for a hearing."




1 That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate
