ORDINANCE # 184

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LINCOLN COUNTY ESTUARY MANAGEMENT PLAN, SEPTEMBER 1982, AND ESTUARY MANAGEMENT UNITS FOR THE EVALUATION OF LAND AND WATER USES IN LINCOLN COUNTY'S ESTUARIES AS ESTABLISHED IN THE LINCOLN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, AS AMENDED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ORDAINS
as follows:

SECTION I: The Lincoln County Estuary Management Plan, September 1982, as set forth in Exhibit A is hereby adopted and made a part of the Lincoln County Comprehensive Plan.

SECTION II: The Lincoln County Estuary Management Units as set forth on the Lincoln County Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Maps are hereby adopted as set forth in Ordinance # 183.

SECTION III: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: If any portion of the text or maps adopted by the ordinance is declared invalid or void, all other provisions of the text and maps shall remain in effect.

SECTION IV: REPEALER CLAUSE: Lincoln County Ordinance #141 is hereby repealed.

SECTION V: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance takes effect on its adoption.
