AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #155, CHAPTER TWO, SECTION 2.1015, OF THE LINCOLN COUNTY CODE, DISSOLVING THE SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS Section 2.1015 of the Lincoln County Code provides for the creation of a solid waste advisory committee; and

WHEREAS said committee has existed for a number of years and provided valuable service to the county; and

WHEREAS by virtue of the formation of the Lincoln County Consortium for Solid Waste Management and the Consortium User Board, there is duplication of solid waste management advisory services being provided by the user board and the solid waste advisory committee; and

WHEREAS the Board has received a recommendation passed unanimously by the solid waste advisory committee that, in view of the duplication of solid waste management advisory services, the committee be dissolved;

NOW, therefore, the Board hereby ORDAINS as follows:

1. That section 2.1015(1) of the Lincoln County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) The Board may create a solid waste advisory committee or utilize the services of an advisory committee already in existence which performs substantially the same functions as provided for herein. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee as presently constituted is hereby dissolved. In the absence of the committee, the Lincoln County Solid Waste Administrator shall perform all functions of the committee as provided for herein. In the event a committee is created, the committee shall have nine members appointed by the Board, including:

- "(a) county sanitarian, or his authorized representative;
- "(b) two franchisees;
- "(c) six citizen members representative of incorporated and unincorporated geographical areas of the county."
