ORDINANCE # 258

AN ORDINANCE ASSIGNING NEW ROAD NAMES AND NUMBERS WITHIN THE LINCOLN CITY ADDRESSING ZONE and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1983, the board adopted a comprehensive plan providing for an uniform system of addressing and numbering all houses and buildings within the jurisdiction of the county and providing for a method of clarifying duplicate road and highway names and assigning new road names and numbers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to LCC 6.115, the traffic safety engineer, in consultation with the county road department, affected municipalities, and the city of Lincoln City, has ascertained proper road names for the Lincoln City Zone and has made recommendations to the board for road name and road number changes; and

WHEREAS the board has reviewed these recommendations, published notice as required, and received public input as to the propriety of the road name and road number changes, and has determined that the proposed changes are in the public interest;

Now, therefore, the board hereby ORDAINS as follows:

1. That the new names and numbers reflected on the attached exhibit are hereby adopted effective this date;
2. That the traffic safety engineer prepare and maintain a master file of all old and new street names and numbers within each addressing zone for purposes of public inspection.
3. That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
