Ordinance # 251

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #236 SECTION III, ADDING NEW PROVISIONS, LINCOLN COUNTY CODE CHAPTER SEVEN, SECTION 7.320(4), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners hereby ORDAINS as follows:

1. That subsection (4) of section 7.320, be amended to read as follows:

"(4) Any person who alleges an act of discrimination by the county regarding employment opportunity with the county, access to service or access to county facilities may file such complaint with the personnel officer who shall seek to provide a prompt and equitable solution. Should the personnel officer be unable to satisfactorily resolve the complaint, such person may present the complaint to the board. Such complaint may also be filed with the appropriate state or federal compliance agency. Information regarding state and federal compliance agencies may be obtained from the personnel officer."

2. That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
