3 ORDINANCE # 266

4 AMENDMENT TO CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE #258, ASSIGN-  
5 ING NEW ROAD NAMES AND NUMBERS WITHIN THE LINCOLN CITY  
6 ADDRESSING ZONE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

7 WHEREAS, on December 7, 1983, the board adopted a  
8 comprehensive plan providing for a uniform system of addressing  
9 and numbering all houses and buildings within the jurisdiction  
10 of the county and providing for a method of clarifying dupli-  
11 cate road and highway names and assigning new road names and  
12 numbers; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to LCC 6.115, the traffic safety  
14 engineer, in consultation with the County Road Department,  
15 affected municipalities, and the City of Lincoln City,  
16 ascertained proper road names and numbers for the Lincoln  
17 City Zone, and the board, in Ordinance #258, adopted those  
18 recommended road names and numbers; and

19 WHEREAS, the board has reviewed recommendations, published  
20 notice as required, and received public input as to the  
21 propriety of additional road name and road number changes  
22 for public and private roads within the Lincoln City addressing  
23 zone and has determined that the proposed changes are in the  
24 public interest;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

26 1. That those portions of Ordinance #258 assigning road

1 names and numbers within the Lincoln City addressing zone  
2 are amended by adding the following:

3 <u>Road Number</u>	<u>Road Name</u>
4 1109	North Echo Mountain Road
5 1110	North Durette Drive
6 1111	North Clancy Road
7 5809	South Drift Creek Camp Road

8 2. That the traffic safety engineer make appropriate  
9 revisions on the official county road maps and in the official  
10 county records reflecting these amendments and place appropriate  
11 signs on the respective roads.

12 3. That copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Road  
13 Department, Assessor's Office, the Planning and Development  
14 Department, and the Surveyor's Office.

15 4. That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate  
16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an  
17 emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes  
18 effect upon its adoption.
