Ordinance No. 273

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 7.205 THROUGH 7.345, PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT, LINCOLN COUNTY CODE, AND ALL ORDINANCES CREATING OR AMENDING THE PROVISIONS THEREIN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners has revised the Lincoln County Personnel Management Rules as the official personnel policy for the county; and

WHEREAS the Board desires that for ease of amendment, the rules no longer be incorporated into the Lincoln County Code where they must be amended by ordinance but that the rules be adopted as official policy of the county through resolution; and

WHEREAS to accomplish this end, the current ordinance provisions related to personnel management codified as Lincoln County Code LCC 7.205 through LCC 7.345 and all the ordinances creating or amending those provisions need to be repealed;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

That LCC 7.205 through LCC 7.345 is hereby repealed. Ordinance Nos. 158, 172, 179, 185, 189, 191, 200, 218, 230, 232, 236, 241, 251, and 254, which created and amended those provisions, are hereby repealed.

SECTION II:

That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
