ORDINANCE # 277

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LINCOLN COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 9, SECTIONS 9.005(4) AND 9.015(1), BY REDEFINING CAMPING AND ADDING DESIGNATED PUBLIC ROADS TO REGULATIONS IDENTIFIED THEREIN

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners desires to amend Lincoln County Code Chapter 9, "Parks," to add "public roads" to the ordinance provisions pertaining to prohibitions of overnight camping in designated parks and on county roads;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

That Lincoln County Code Chapter 9, Sections 9.005(4) and 9.015(1) be amended to read as follows: (Deletions in brackets; additions in boldface)

9.005(4)

"Camp" or "camping" means the placing or pitching of tents, the placing of camping or sleeping facility vehicles including, but not limited to: a trailer, mounted camper, or motor vehicle or other equipment for the purpose of staying overnight or for a limited period during proscribed hours at [the] a county park, upon other county property, or upon a [designated] county or public road.

9.015(1)

It shall be unlawful for any person to camp in a county park[, on a designated county road,] or on other county property [either in a tent, trailer, mounted camper, motor vehicle or sleeping facility vehicle], except in areas specifically designated by the county as public camp grounds. It shall be unlawful for any person to camp on a county or public road where the Board of Commissioners, by Board order, has prohibited camping upon that road.

SECTION 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
