ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 205 AND 228 AND ASSIGNING A NEW ROAD NAME WITHIN THE TOLEDO ADDRESSING ZONE

Whereas on December 7, 1983, the Board adopted a comprehensive plan providing for a uniform system of addressing and numbering all houses and buildings within the jurisdiction of the county and providing for a method of clarifying duplicate road and highway names and assigning new road names and numbers; and

WHEREAS pursuant to LCC 6.115, the Traffic Safety Engineer, in consultation with the County Road Department and the City of Newport, ascertained proper road names and numbers for the Toledo Addressing Zone, and the Board adopted those recommended road names and numbers in Ordinances 205 and 228; and

WHEREAS the Board has received a report from Scott Branchfield, Addressing Technician, requesting changes in the name of a certain street in the Toledo Addressing Zone, and the Board having reviewed recommendations of staff, having published notice as required, and having received public input as to the propriety of the proposed change at a public hearing held July 21, 1993, and having determined that the proposed change is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

That those portions of Ordinances No. 205 and 228 assigning road names and numbers within the Toledo Addressing Zone are amended as follows:

1 **SECTION II:**

2 That the County Traffic Safety Engineer and the
3 Addressing Technician make appropriate revisions on the
4 official county road maps and the official addressing maps
5 reflecting this amendment.

6 **SECTION III:**

7 That copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Road
8 Department, Assessor's Office, and the Addressing Office.

9 **SECTION IV:**

10 That the Addressing Department change all addressing data
11 bases to reflect the adopted street name, notify all property
12 owners and emergency service agencies by mail of the street
13 name change, and initiate procedures to change street signs to
14 reflect the adopted street name.

15 **SECTION V:**

16 That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public, peace, health, and safety, an
18 emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance takes
19 effect upon its adoption.
