ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 205, 238, 258, 259 AND 266
ASSIGNING NEW ROAD NAMES WITHIN THE DEPOE BAY AND LINCOLN CITY
ADDRESSING ZONES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS on December 7, 1983, the Board adopted a comprehensive plan providing for a uniform system of addressing and numbering all houses and buildings within the jurisdiction of the county and providing for a method of clarifying duplicate road and highway names and assigning new road names and numbers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to LCC 6.115, the Traffic Safety Engineer, in consultation with the County Road Department and the Cities of Depoe Bay and Lincoln City ascertained proper road names and numbers for the Depoe Bay and Lincoln City Zones, and the Board adopted those recommended road names and numbers in Ordinances 205, 238, 258, 259 and 266; and

WHEREAS the Board has received a petition requesting changes in the names of streets in the Depoe Bay and Lincoln City Addressing Zones, and the Board having reviewed recommendations, having published notice as required, and received public input as to the propriety of the proposed changes at a public hearing held June 27, 1990, and having determined that the proposed changes are in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

That those portions of Ordinances No. 205, 238, 258, 259 and 266 assigning road names and numbers within the Depoe Bay and Lincoln City Addressing Zones are amended as follows:

<u>Road Number</u>	<u>Road Name Changes</u>
11011	Salmon River Frontage Road to Old Farm Road/N
6165	Cushing Court

SECTION II:

That the County Traffic Safety Engineer and the Addressing Technician make appropriate revisions on the official

1 county road maps and the official addressing maps reflecting
2 these amendments.

3 SECTION III:

4 That copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Road
5 Department, Assessor's Office, and the Addressing Office.

6 SECTION IV:

7 That the Addressing Department change all addressing
8 data bases to reflect the adopted street names, notify all
9 property owners and emergency service agencies by mail of the
10 street name changes, and initiate procedures to change street
11 signs to reflect the adopted street names.

12 SECTION V:

13 That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an
15 emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect
16 upon its adoption.
