3 ORDINANCE NO. 295

4 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 205, 275, 276, AND 289
5 ASSIGNING NEW ROAD NAMES WITHIN THE NEWPORT ADDRESSING ZONE AND
6 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

7 WHEREAS on December 7, 1983, the Board adopted a
8 comprehensive plan providing for a uniform system of addressing
9 and numbering all houses and buildings within the jurisdiction of
10 the county and providing for a method of clarifying duplicate
11 road and highway names and assigning new road names and numbers;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to LCC 6.115, the Traffic Safety
14 Engineer, in consultation with the County Road Department and the
15 City of Newport ascertained proper road names and numbers for the
16 Newport Addressing Zone, and the Board adopted those recommended
17 road names and numbers in Ordinances 205, 275, 276, and 289; and

18 WHEREAS the Board has received a petition requesting a
19 change in the name of a street in the Newport Addressing Zone,
20 and the Board having reviewed recommendations of staff, having
21 published notice as required, and received public input as to the
22 propriety of the proposed change at a public hearing held
23 August 1, 1990, and having determined that the proposed change is
24 in the public interest;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

26 SECTION I:

27 That those portions of Ordinances No. 205, 275, 276,
28 and 289 assigning road names and numbers within the Newport
29 Addressing Zone are amended as follows:

<u>Road Number</u>	<u>Road Name Changes</u>
440	From N.E. Landfill Lane to N.E. Avery Street

30 SECTION II:

31 That the County Traffic Safety Engineer and the
32 Addressing Technician make appropriate revisions on the official

county road maps and the official addressing maps reflecting these amendments.

SECTION III:

That copies of this ordinance be furnished to the Road Department, Assessor's Office, and the Addressing Office.

SECTION IV:

That the Addressing Department change all addressing data bases to reflect the adopted street name, notify all property owners and emergency service agencies by mail of the street name change, and initiate procedures to change street signs to reflect the adopted street name.

SECTION V:

That this ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance takes effect upon its adoption.
