ORDINANCE # 323

Relating to appeals from decisions of the county sanitarian; amending LCC 2.210 and 2.1175; and declaring an emergency.

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

LCC 2.210 is amended to read:

2.210 Appeals from Decisions of the Administrator Relating to Franchises

(1) The Board may, upon its own motion or upon the request of an interested person or affected public agency or body, review any decision of the administrator or committee and may affirm, modify, or rescind the decision of the administrator.

(2) In reviewing appealed actions, the Board may request the recommendation of the committee, and hold public hearings after notice to affected persons.

(3) This section applies only to decisions of the administrator relating to enforcement of provisions in existing sewage disposal franchises granted pursuant to this chapter.

SECTION 2.

LCC 2.1175 is amended to read:

2.1175 Appeals from Decisions of the Administrator Relating to Franchises

(1) The Board may, upon its own motion or upon the request of an interested person or affected public agency or body, review any decision of the administrator or committee and may affirm, modify, or rescind the decision of the administrator.

1 (2) In reviewing appealed actions, the Board may request the recommendation of
2 the committee, and hold public hearings after notice to affected persons.

3 (3) This section applies only to decisions of the administrator relating to
4 enforcement of provisions in existing solid waste disposal franchises granted
5 pursuant to this chapter.

7 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take
9 effect upon its passage.
