6 **Relating to the building code; creating new provisions; and declaring an emergency.**

8 Whereas the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners has adopted a resolution
9 authorizing application for delegation of the electrical inspection program from the State of
10 Oregon to Lincoln County in accordance with ORS 479.855 and OAR 918-300-130
11 (Resolution # 94-14-12A); and

12 Whereas OAR 918-300-140 requires the inclusion of specific provisions in county
13 ordinance relating to the electrical code beyond simple adoption of that code as already
14 accomplished by LCC 3.010; therefore,

15 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

16 **SECTION 1.**

17 Section 2 of this Ordinance is added to and made a part of LCC chapter 3, as
18 indicated.

1 **SECTION 2.**

2 **3.012 Additional Specific Adoption of the State Electrical Code**

3 **(1) In addition to, and not in lieu of, the provisions of LCC 3.010, in accordance**
4 **with OAR 918-300-140(1), Lincoln County specifically hereby adopts the State of**
5 **Oregon Electrical Specialty Code as adopted by the Building Codes Division Electrical**
6 **Board in OAR 918-290-010 to 918-290-140, and the electrical provisions of the State of**
7 **Oregon One and Two Family Dwelling Code as adopted by the Building Codes**
8 **Division in OAR 918-480-000 to 918-480-010.**

9 **(2) In addition to, and not in lieu of, the provisions of LCC 3.020 and 3.025, in**
10 **accordance with OAR 918-300-140(2), pursuant to ORS 479.550(1) and except as**
11 **otherwise provided by ORS 479.540 or other applicable state law, no person shall work**
12 **on any new electrical installation for which a permit has not been issued by the**
13 **Building Official.**

14 **(3) In accordance with OAR 918-300-140(3), in addition to any other authority**
15 **and power granted to the Building Official, except where inconsistent with other**
16 **provisions of law, the Building Official may enforce the provisions of the specialty**
17 **codes against any person regardless of whether a permit, certificate, license or other**
18 **indicia of authority has been issued. The Building Official may conduct an**
19 **investigation, take sworn testimony, subpoena persons and records, order corrective**
20 **action, and issue an order to stop all or any part of the work under the applicable**
21 **specialty code.**

1 **(4) In accordance with OAR 918-300-140(5), minor labels are authorized for**
2 **minor installations identified by the State of Oregon Building Codes Division Electrical**
3 **Board. The provisions of OAR 918-310-010 to 918-310-100 are adopted by reference**
4 **as the requirements and procedures for the Building Official.**

5 **(5) In accordance with OAR 918-300-140(6), temporary permit requirements**
6 **and procedures adopted by the Building Codes Division Electrical Board in OAR 918-**
7 **260-265 are adopted by reference as the requirements and procedures for the Building**
8 **Official. Holiday and after hours notices to the Building Official can be given by**
9 **facsimile or recording device at telephone numbers available from the Building**
10 **Official.**

11 **(6) In addition to, and not in lieu of, the provisions of LCC 3.030, in accordance**
12 **with OAR 918-300-140(7), the electrical permit fees and method of computation**
13 **adopted by the Building Codes Division Electrical Board in OAR 918-260-210 to 918-**
14 **260-260 are adopted by reference as the electrical permit fees and method of**
15 **computation for the Building Official. In addition, a plan review charge shall be a**
16 **percentage of the electrical permit fee as determined by the Building Official.**



1 **SECTION 3.**


2 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health




