14           **6.600 Transfer of Jurisdiction Over Ways of Necessity**

15           In accordance with the provisions of ORS 376.200, jurisdiction over the  
16 establishment of ways of necessity under ORS 376.150 to 376.200 is removed and  
17 transferred to the circuit court.

18           **SECTION 3.**

19           LCC 6.605, 6.610, 6.615, 6.620, 6.625, 6.630 and 6.635 are repealed.


and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.


