Relating to roads; creating new provisions; and declaring an emergency.

---

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

Section 2 is added to and made a part of LCC chapter 6, as indicated.

**SECTION 2.**

**6.420 Temporary No Parking and Speed Limits**

**(1) The County Roadmaster, and the duly appointed agents and employees of the County Roadmaster, are delegated authority to designate a portion of any public road subject to the jurisdiction of the county as a no parking zone, for a period of time not to exceed 30 days. Any portion so designated shall be clearly marked and posted as no parking.**

**(2) The County Roadmaster, and the duly appointed agents and employees of the County Roadmaster, are delegated authority under ORS 810.180(5) to designate speeds for vehicles, for a period of time not to exceed 30 days, upon any portion of any public road subject to the jurisdiction of the county upon which temporary conditions constituting a danger to the public exist or above, below or upon which construction or maintenance**


1 work is being carried on so close to the roadway as to be a danger to passing traffic or to be  
2 endangered by passing traffic. Any restrictions or limitations imposed under this  
3 subsection shall be imposed by a proper order of the County Roadmaster or duly  
4 appointed agent or employee. A sign giving notice of the restrictions or limitations  
5 contained in the order shall be maintained in a conspicuous manner and placed at each end  
6 of the affected roadway, and at such other places as may be necessary to inform the public.  
7 The restrictions or limitations are effective when the signs giving notice are erected.

8 **SECTION 3.**


9 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
10 and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
