6 **Relating to courthouse parking; creating new provisions; amending LCC 7.615;**
7 **repealing LCC 7.620 and 7.625; and declaring an emergency.**

9 The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

10 **SECTION 1.**

11 LCC 7.615 is amended to read:

12 7.615 Parking Rules

13 During the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on work days, the following rules shall
14 apply:

15 (1) Employees of the county and the State of Oregon, **while on duty**, shall not park in
16 any parking space abutting the main courthouse building, **except as authorized pursuant to**
17 **subsection (4) of this section.**

18 (2) **Public** parking in the space abutting the courthouse [*by the public*] shall be limited
19 to [*90*] 60 minutes.

20 [[*2*]] (3) Only authorized persons shall park in any parking space designated for
21 loading or for disabled persons.

1 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) Only authorized persons shall park in any parking space specifically
2 designated for a particular individual or department by the Board of Commissioners.

3 ~~[(4)]~~ (5) No person shall park in the parking area except in designated parking spaces.

4 *[(5) Any county or state employee vehicle parked upon the courthouse grounds during*
5 *the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excepting week ends, holidays, and employee days off,*
6 *shall display a county parking sticker which must be conspicuously displayed on the rear*
7 *window of all vehicles except motorcycles, which shall have the stickers conspicuously placed*
8 *in a reasonable manner.]*

9 **SECTION 2.**

10 Section 3 is added to and made a part of LCC chapter 7, as indicated.

11 **SECTION 3.**

12 **7.618 Enforcement**

13 **Enforcement of LCC 7.615 may be carried out by one or more of the following**
14 **methods:**

15 **(1) Citation:**

16 **A vehicle parked in violation of LCC 7.615 is subject to being cited for a parking**
17 **violation in accordance with the Oregon Vehicle Code, LCC chapter 10, or both.**

18 **(2) Impoundment:**

19 **A vehicle parked in violation of LCC 7.615 is subject to being impounded in**
20 **accordance with the procedures provided in ORS 809.725 and 819.180.**

21 **(3) Nuisance Abatement:**

NOTE: Matter in boldfaced type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing ordinance to be omitted. New sections are in boldfaced type.

1 A nuisance abatement action in accordance with LCC chapter 10 may be filed
2 against any person who repeatedly parks in violation of LCC 7.615.

3 (4) Personnel Discipline for County or State Employees:

4 A person who violates LCC 7.615, and who is an employee of Lincoln County or
5 the State of Oregon, is subject to the imposition of discipline for that violation.

6 SECTION 4.


7 LCC 7.620 and 7.625 are repealed.

8 SECTION 5.

9 This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
10 health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon
11 its passage.


